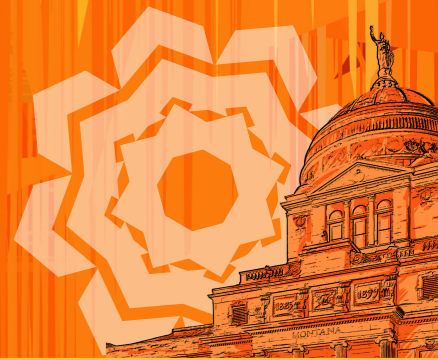

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES VOTING SCORECARD

This year, a super majority of our representatives chose to ignore thousands of public comments urging them to protect the rights of all people in Montana, particularly trans, non-binary, and Two-Spirit youth. Instead, they voted against their constituents, participating in what was undoubtedly the most aggressively & explicitly anti-trans and anti-queer legislative session in U.S. history. Despite the hate and ignorance that was spewed this session, no matter the ways the state seeks to control and erase us, we have always been here and we have no plans to leave.

HB 361 - Teachers legally cannot address transphobic bullying

This bill has been amended many times and now only explicitly bans drag story hours in publicly-funded schools and libraries, as well as “sexually-oriented” performances in public spaces where minors are present. Despite amendments, the bill still legally characterizes drag as inherently sexual.

SB 458 - Defines “sex” in the legal code

Issue: Queer & trans rights

FMT Position: Oppose

SB 458 “defines sex in Montana law” in a way that erases intersex people from the legal code, strips anti-discrimination protections away from intersex, trans, nonbinary, and Two Spirit people, prevents people from receiving documentation that accurately reflects their gender, and inserts a harmful and biologically inaccurate definition

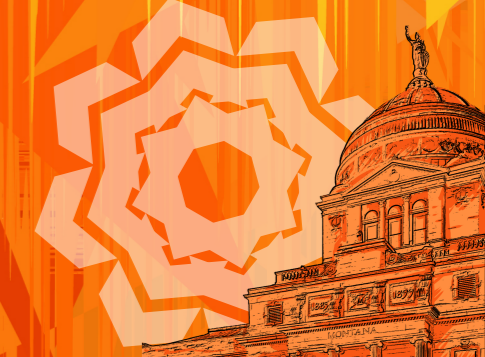
