

# REPRODUCTIVE RIGHTS

At the 2025 Montana Legislature



Session started on the heels of a clear victory for reproductive rights: a constitutional amendment codifying Montanans' right to abortion and reproductive health care. Yet some legislators still tried to pass harmful policies - often relying on misinformation and fear. And while we rarely see legislative wins for reproductive rights, this legislature managed to pull one off.

## HB 316: Constitutional amendment to define person

**SPONSOR** Lee Deming (R)

HD-54, Yellowstone

**FMT POSITION** Oppose

**OUTCOME** Failed

HB 316 would have amended Montana's constitution to define 'personhood' as life beginning at conception, threatening access to abortion, Plan B, IVF and most other reproductive health care options. This bill required a two thirds majority vote to pass.

## HB 388: Create pregnancy center autonomy and rights of expression act

**SPONSOR** Amy Regier (R)

HD-6, Flathead

**FMT POSITION** Oppose

**OUTCOME** Passed

HB 388 prohibits any government regulation, including patient privacy protections, of Crisis Pregnancy Centers. These centers provide options of counseling and pregnancy testing with the primary goal of preventing people from accessing abortion care.

## HB 475: Regulate restraints on women while giving childbirth

**SPONSOR** James Reavis (D)

HD-47, Yellowstone

**FMT POSITION** Support

**OUTCOME** Passed

HB 475 bans the practice of shackling pregnant inmates during labor and childbirth.
